

General Information for Mexico's Universities

Entrance Exams:

Study for your CENEVAL.net subject exam as early as Sophomore/Junior year (exams change very little each year). You can study online and take a class here in Durango. Request an exam study guide (by subject) at CENEVAL.net. Many of the guides are free. Register for your exam here: <http://www.ceneval.edu.mx/ceneval-web/content.do?page=0>. The cost is approximately \$1,250 for your exam.

If your test results do not allow you to get into your career of choice, talk with the school about attending while waiting a semester for access to your career program. Ms. Vicky's son got into his career this way and it may be a way for you to attend the school you want as well.

Exam location: you must go to the university to which you are applying to take the exam.

Number of times you may take the exam to improve your score: UJED only gives the exam once. UDEM allows a student to take the exam twice. Contact target universities to learn their policy.

Admission exam date for **public** universities is usually in June, near ASD's graduation date. The exam cost is between \$600 & \$700 pesos. At UJED, exam registration is April and May for the June exam date, but all dates can change. Please check at your target universities.

Admission exam date for **private** universities: you must contact the university directly. Some use [CENEVAL](#), some have their own exams, and others use the SAT or TOEFL results. Some exam dates are as early as February for school beginning in August/September.

Costs:

The cost for Mexico's **private** universities are calculated on a per-unit cost. The cost per semester ranges from approximately \$70,000 to \$90,000. Each semester you must also pay an enrollment fee.

For example at Anáhuac the cost per unit is= \$2,056. If a student takes 4 subjects and each subject is worth 5 credits, then the semester will cost $4 \times 5 = 20 \times \$2,056 = \$41,120$ (plus the enrollment fee).

The cost for Mexico's public universities range from approximately \$2,000 for UJED to \$6,000 or more/semester.

Remember, a better university means a better future for you, so begin studying early!!

Request your Kardex records from the Control Escolar at ASD at lhernandez@cadurango.mx. In your email request, provide Ms Lizett with the email or address to which the Kardex record must be sent.

Other items that must be sent to your target **Private** university are (this list may only be partial. Please check with the admissions office at your target university):

- **Admission** Application
- Kardex academic record from ASD (Control Escolar, lhernandez@cadurango.mx)
- Proof of graduation from ASD (Control Escolar, lhernandez@cadurango.mx)
- Exam results (university)
- Birth certificate
- Copy of official identification, like the INE or your passport
- Photos, black and white (current) with your name written on the back.
- Copy of a utility receipt with your home address that is less than three months old (water, electricity, phone)
- Copy of your CURP (2 copies)
- All fees required by the university for your career

Items that must be sent or taken to your target **Public** university are (This list may only be partial. Please check with the admissions office at your target university):

- Application printed from the school website
- Copy of your CURP (2 copies)
- Copy of a utility receipt with your home address that is less than three months old (water, electricity, phone)
- Kardex academic record from ASD (Control Escolar, lhernandez@cadurango.mx)
- Proof of graduation from ASD (Control Escolar, lhernandez@cadurango.mx)
- Birth certificate (2 copies)
- Photos (current, 2-4 copies), black and white. Write your name on the back.
- Copy of official identification, like the INE or your passport
- All fees required by the university (\$2,000 for UJED for the first semester enrollment fee and one time fee of \$500 to \$700 depending on career)

In all cases, be sure that you note on your calendar the deadlines for paying your fees and for submitting your documents. Check their website frequently for changes and stay in touch with the admissions advisor at your school to be sure that they have received your information.

What steps can you take right now?

- 1) Career Research. What do you like to do? What impact do you want to have on the world? For assessments and great ideas please see the page on Careers in the College Counseling section.
- 2) Investigate universities that have your careers. Study their websites, plan a visit, give them a call, note their cost, deadlines and their admissions procedures. Each are different.

- 3) Study for the admission exam. Some require the SAT, others require the CENEVAL, and others have their own special admission exam. Know your university requirements and begin your practice now.
